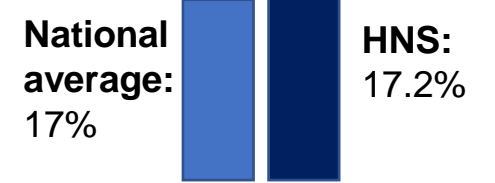
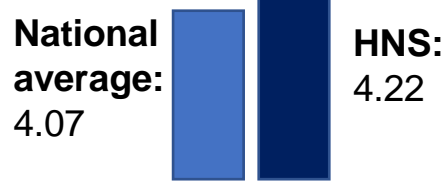


Hackney New School progress and attainment metrics GCSE 2019

The figures below show the progress and attainment metrics for students who sat their GCSEs in 2019 at Hackney New School.



PROGRESS 8

EXPLANATION

- Progress 8 measures the progress made from when students leave primary school in Year 6 to when they leave secondary school in Year 11
- The 'expected' measure of progress is zero, therefore, students that have a positive Progress 8 have made more than the expected amount of progress since they left primary school



ATTAINMENT 8

EXPLANATION

- There are two Attainment 8 metrics:
 - Average Attainment 8
 - Total Attainment 8
- Average Attainment 8 measures the average grade across eight qualifications
- Total Attainment 8 measures the total grade score across eight qualifications



BASIC

EXPLANATION

- The 'basic' metric refers to the percentage of students that achieve a Grade 5 or above in both English and maths



ENGLISH BACCALAUREATE

EXPLANATION

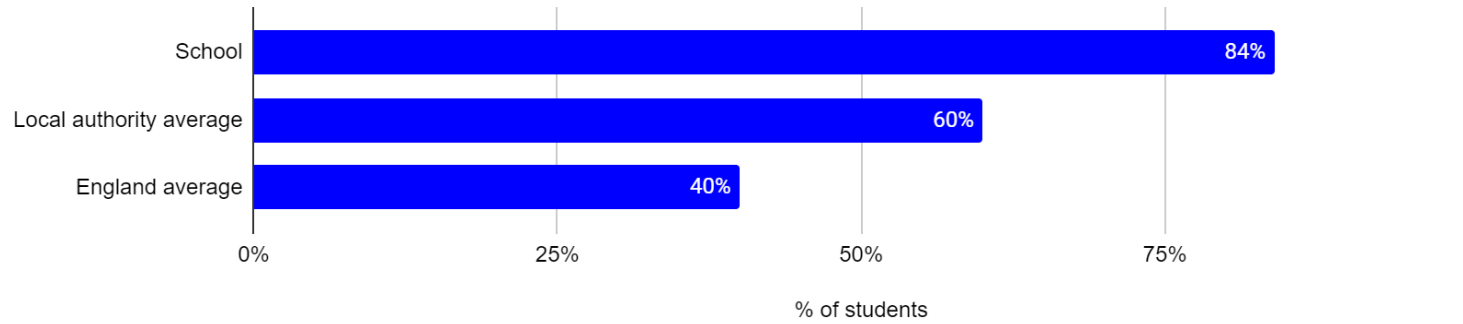
- The English Baccalaureate metric refers to the percentage of students that achieved a Grade 5 or above in EBacc subjects
- The eight EBacc subjects include:
 - English literature
 - English language
 - Mathematics
 - Combined science (or triple science)
 - Modern foreign language
 - Geography or history



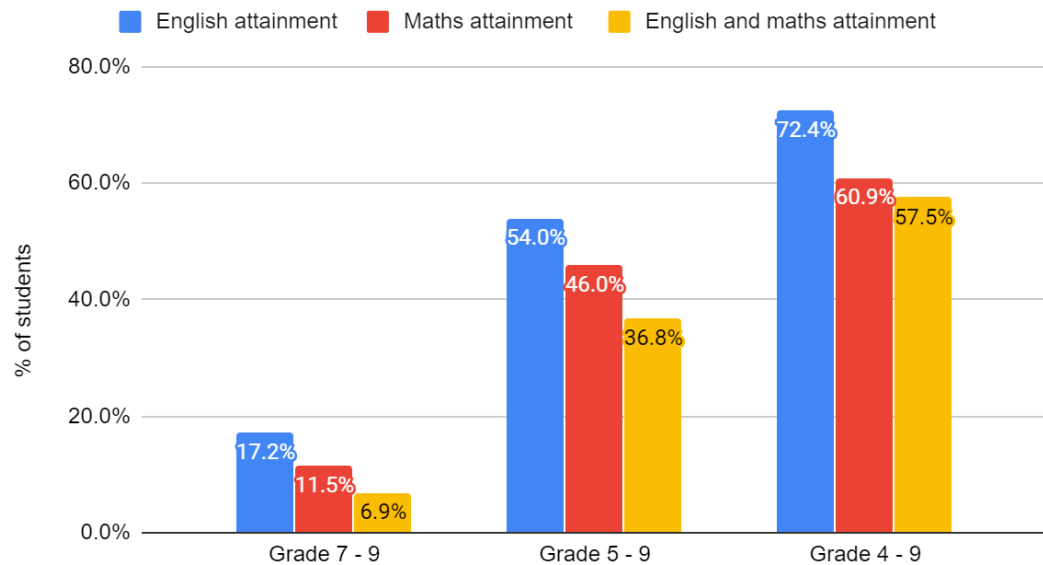
