



Year 7 Catch-Up Premium Grant Report

Secondary Schools receive this premium grant to support year 7 pupils who fail to reach the government's 'expected standard' in reading and maths by the time they leave primary school. Previously this was a Level 4 in the SATs, it is now a score of 100,

In 2019/20 the allocation of funds for this purpose to Hackney New School was £8,510.

As this is a comparatively small sum, HNS uses our catch up premium to support in the employment of qualified English and/or maths teachers. We teach weaker students and those with EAL in small groups and provide booster sessions.

During the academic year 2019/20 we will use the grant to support funding additional teaching staff in English and maths. The impact of the intervention will be seen through the percentage of students making expected progress in English and maths on their DPR reports.
